

THOMAS HINES TUITION GRANT

National Institute of Golf Management

PURPOSE

The Thomas Hines Tuition Grant is funded through the students of the NIGM each year via involvement in activities designed by the Board of Regents and conducted with the assistance of the Graduate Seminar class at each year's school. These grants are intended to offer one-year school opportunities to individuals within the golf industry based on their merits. Grants include tuition only. Tuition Grants are available for Second Year Students and Graduate Seminar Students.

APPLICATIONS

Applications for tuition grants are to be sent directly to the National Training Center at Oglebay Park, Wheeling, West Virginia for distribution to the Trustees. The Trustees will make a decision based on the merits of the applicants.

Applications will be made available each year to First Year, Second Year and Graduate students for the following year. Applications will also be available by request by contacting the Oglebay National Training Center or the NGF.

Applications must be postmarked by June 16th of any given year for consideration. Tuition grants will be offered by July 1st of any given year prior to the next school. Tuition grant recipients will be contacted by certified mail and by the Past Chairman. Recipients will have (30) thirty days to accept or deny the grant. Applications must be accompanied by a resume and three letters of recommendation by persons not related by family. Additionally, a letter must accompany applications from the applicant as to why they are in the business and why they are applying for the tuition grant.

APPLICANTS

Applicants must be employed on a full time basis with a public, municipal, government, resort or private golf facility. Applicants must have been employed for a minimum of one full year within the golf industry. Applicants must be at least 21 years of age.

Children, relatives, or employees of Board Members, Trustees, Regents Emeritus, Oglebay staff or NGF staff are not eligible for consideration purposes.
